Fast Track to Certified Proficiency

PMI is a 12-month professional development program that begins with **PMI Production**, four days of interactive classroom training on fundamental laundry production and operations, emphasizing key principles of:

- Productivity
- Quality

- Safety
- Sustainability

During the next 12 months, students participate in a series of self-paced, online modules on topics such as human resources, communications, finance, time/project management and business ethics. Students then meet again at **PMI Management** for four days of interactive sessions that further refine their production and laundry-specific management skills.

Attendees emerge from PMI with advanced tactics for:

- Relating to and communicating with colleagues across all departments
- Managing plant workforce
