## GET ON BOARD WITH PMI—YOUR FAST TRACK TO CERTIFIED PROFICIENCY

PMI is a comprehensive 12-month program that includes two four-day sessions comprised of on-site workshops and group exercises. Sandwiched between Sessions I and II is an online component providing reinforcement and further enrichment.

**SESSION I:** Attendees will benefit from four days of interactive classroom-style lectures, group exercises and presentations led by subject matter experts. Learn the processes and procedures to succeed at fundamentals of laundry production and operational essentials such as:

- Plant Production
- Quality Control and Plant Efficiency
- Safety Awareness, including PPEs and HAZCOM
- Sustainability
- Staff Management (scheduling/managing workflow)
- Productivity and Capacity Measurements and Metrics
- Communicating and Collaborating
- Customer Service

Following Session I, students will participate in a series of self-paced, online modules on topics such as human resources, communications, finance, time/project management and business ethics. Students meet again 12 months later for Session II for four more days of interactive instruction that further refines production and laundry-specific management skills.
