Clean your hands often

Cover your cough and sneeze! Use a tissue to cover your mouth and nose. If you don't have a tissue, sneeze or cough into your arm.

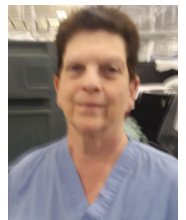
FROM OUR GENERAL MANAGER
